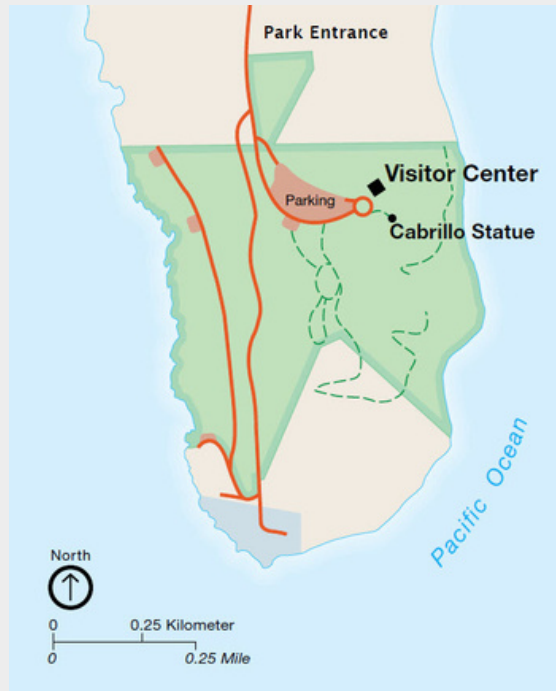




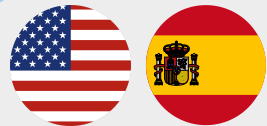
484TH ANNIVERSARY LANDING OF CABRILLO IN SAN DIEGO



Juan Rodríguez Cabrillo was born in Palma de Micer Gilio (today Palma del Rio) Córdoba, Spain.

Cabrillo departed from the port of Barra de Navidad, New Spain (today Mexico), on June 27, 1542.

Three months later they landed at “a very good port”, which today is known as San Diego Bay (this is 78 years before the Mayflower arrived to America!).

Spain, within 30 years, changed the way we would envision our Earth forever?

1492 - The first trip that Christopher Columbus made proving that there was land on the other side of the Atlantic Ocean. Later named the Americas or American Continent.

1513 – Vasco Nuñez de Balboa discovery of a great Ocean on the other side of the new American Continent.

1522 – The first circumnavigation of the Earth by Magellan – Elcano. Magellan was killed in the Philippines, so he never completed the voyage.
